FOUNDATIONS

Paragraph 1. *"Ultimately within **two weeks after the order**, Claimant will grant access to external counsel to Defendants and any external experts hired by Defendants (i) all Claimant's licenses for smartphone manufacturers since 2015 and (ii) all agreements in which a license or a non-assert has been agreed that includes EP 587 and/or a family member thereof (EP and/or foreign), with the exception of licenses relating to payment terminals or electronic payments, concluded since 2015 including earlier licenses in case of a renewal of such license in the period since 2015, to the extent not already provided following the Order of 13 April 2026, including in particular any license agreement concluded with █████ █████ and █████ since 2015 (hereinafter together: the "Materials")"*

And paragraph 11¹. "The deadline for the Statement of Defence shall be **11 September**

The Judge-Rapporteur sees no reason not to allow this joint request. So will be ordered.

ORDER

The Court orders the following variations to the operative part of the order of 28 May 2026 for case 2246/2025:

1. Ultimately within **two weeks after the order**, Claimant will grant access to external counsel to Defendants and any external experts hired by Defendants (i) all Claimant’s licenses for smartphone manufacturers since 2015 and (ii) all agreements in which a license or a non-assert has been agreed that includes EP 587 and/or a family member thereof (EP and/or foreign), with the exception of licenses relating to payment terminals or electronic payments, concluded since 2015 including earlier licenses in case of a renewal of such license in the period since 2015, to the extent not already provided following the Order of 13 April 2026, including in particular any license agreement concluded with ██████████ ██████████ and ██████████ since 2015 (hereinafter together: the “Materials”);
11. The deadline for the Statement of Defence shall be **11 September 2026**.
